

THE CONTRACTOR SHALL ADJUST TO GRADE ALL FACILITIES (INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO VALVE BOXES, PULL BOXES, MAINTENANCE HOLE RIM AND COVERS, METER BOXES) WITHIN THE LIMITS OF WORK AND/OR AS DIRECTED BY ENGINEER. THE FACILITIES SHALL BE ADJUSTED AS SET FORTH IN SJCO STANDARD DRAWING NO. CW-R36 AND/OR AS DIRECTED BY ENGINEER.
- 14. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL PROVIDE ALL LIGHTS, BARRICADES, SIGNS, FLAGMEN OR OTHER DEVICES NECESSARY FOR PUBLIC SAFETY.
- ALL STATIONS REFER TO DISTANCES ALONG STREET CENTERLINE, PERPENDICULAR TO OR RADIALLY OPPOSITE CENTERLINE STATIONS, UNLESS

- ALL NEW CONCRETE FLATWORK SHALL BE DRILLED AND DOWELED AND/OR KEYED INTO EXISTING FLATWORK IN ACCORDANCE WITH COUNTY STANDARD PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS.
- THE CONTRACTOR SHALL PROVIDE AND MAINTAIN TEMPORARY SIGNS FOR ALL REGULATORY TRAFFIC SIGNS REMOVED DURING THE CONSTRUCTION.
- IT IS PROHIBITED TO DISCHARGE ANYTHING EXCEPT CLEAN WATER INTO THE

- CONTRACTOR SHALL PROTECT ALL BENCHMARKS AND SURVEYED MONUMENTS DURING CONSTRUCTION, DAMAGED OR REMOVED MONUMENTS SHALL BE REPLACED, WITH THE SAME ORDER OF ACCURACY, AT THE CONTRACTOR'S
- ROADWAY TO OPEN EACH AFTERNOON FOLLOWING CONSTRUCTION WORK. TRENCHES OR OPEN EXCAVATIONS SHALL BE COVERED WITH NON-SKID TRENCH PLATES PROPERLY SIZED AT ALL TIMES WHEN IMMEDIATE WORK WITHIN EXCAVATIONS IS NOT TAKING PLACE.

AIR PRESSURE TEST:

- EACH SECTION OF SEWER AND CASING SHALL BE TESTED BETWEEN MANHOLES BY PLUGGING AND BRACING ALL OPENINGS IN THE SEWER MAIN LINE AND THE UPPER ENDS OF ALL HOUSE CONNECTION SEWERS. THE LEAKAGE TEST SHALL BE CONDUCTED IN THE FOLLOWING MANNER:
- A. AIR SHALL BE INTRODUCED INTO THE PIPELINE UNTIL 3.0 PSI GAUGE PRESSURE HAS BEEN REACHED, AT WHICH TIME THE FLOW OF AIR SHALL BE REDUCED AND THE INTERNAL AIR PRESSURE SHALL BE MAINTAINED BETWEEN 2.5 AND 3.5 PSI FOR AT LEAST 2 MINUTES PRESSURE IN THE PIPELINE SHALL BE CONSISTENTLY MONITORED BY A GAUGE AND SHALL NOT BE ALLOWED TO EXCEED 5 PSI.
- 8. AFTER THE TEMPERATURE HAS STABILIZED AND NO AIR LEAKS AT THE PLUGS HAVE BEEN FOUND, THE AIR PRESSURE SHALL BE PERMITTED TO DROP TO 2.5 PSI, THEN A STOPWATCH OR SWEEP-SECOND-HAND WATCH SHALL BE USED TO DETERMINE THE TIME LAPSE REQUIRED FOR THE AIR PRESSURE DROP TO 1.5 PSI
- C. IF THE TIME LAPSE IS LESS THAN 60 SECONDS, THE NECESSARY REPAIRS MUST BE MADE PRIOR TO ACCEPTANCE BY THE ENGINEER.

SURVEY MONUMENT PRESERVATION:

THE PERMITTEE IS RESPONSIBLE FOR THE PRESERVATION OF SURVEY MONUMENTS LOCATED WITHIN THE AREA OF WORK HEREIN PERMITTED, PRIOR TO THE START OF CONSTRUCTION, SURVEY MONUMENTS THAT POTENTIALLY MAY BE DISTURBED SHALL BE LOCATED AND REFERENCED BY A LICENSED LAND SURVEYOR, AND A CORNER RECORD FILED WITH THE COUNTY SURVEYOR. ANY SURVEY MONUMENTS DISTURBED DURING THE COURSE OF CONSTRUCTION SHALL BE REESTABLISHED BY A LICENSED LAND SURVEYOR AND ANOTHER CORNER RECORD FILED WITH THE COUNTY SURVEYOR. (LAND SURVEYORS' ACT SECTION 8771)

1. This permit is issued under and subject to all laws and ordinances of agencies-governing the encroachment herein permitted. See the following references:

SAN JOAQUIN COUNTY ORDINANCES NUMBERED: 324, 441, 648, 662, 672, 695, 700, 860, 892, 3359, and 3675.

- 2. It is understood and agreed by the Permittee that the performance of any work under this permit shall constitute an acceptance of all the provisions contained herein and failure on the Permittee's part to comply with any provision will be cause for revocation of this permit. Except as otherwise provided for public agencies and franchise holders, this permit is revocable on five days notice.
- 3. All work shall be done subject to the supervision of and the satisfaction of the grantor. The Permittee shall at all times during the progress of the work keep the County Highway in as neat and clean condition as is possible and upon completion of the work authorized herein, shall leave the County Highway in a thoroughly neat, clean and usable condition.
- 4.
