In compliance with your request of **08/12/2016**, permission is hereby granted to do work in County right-of-way as shown on attached application and subject to all the terms, conditions and restrictions written below or printed as general or special provisions on any part of this form. See reverse side and attached sheet, if any.

Trench excavations for service connections will not be permitted within ten feet (10') of pavement centerline unless otherwise approved by the Director. Surface of trench patches shall match in kind and be smooth and even with that of abutting surface. Special attention shall be given to depth of utilities through roadside area in anticipation of future drainage facilities, road profile and/or frontage development. All underground utility facilities are to be established and accurately dimensioned on sketches from surveyed centerline of road right of way, or from right of way (border) lines.

Permittee shall call the Department of Public Works, Field Engineering Division (Permit Inspections) at (209)953-7421 at least forty-eight hours prior to beginning any work within the County right of way. All work performed under this permit shall conform to the rules and regulations pertaining to safety established by the California Division of Industrial Safety and Cal-OSHA.

The jobsite shall be kept in a safe condition at all times by the daily removal of any excess dirt or debris which might be a hazard to either pedestrian or automobile traffic. All necessary traffic convenience and warning devices and personnel shall be provided, placed and maintained by and at the sole expense of the Permittee in accordance with the latest edition of the CALTRANS Manual of Traffic Control.

After completion of the work permitted herein, all debris, lumber, barricades, or any excess material shall be removed and the jobsite left in a neat workmanlike manner. Immediately following completion of construction permitted herein, Permittee shall fill out and mail notice of completion (see attached post card) provided by Grantor.

ENCROACHMENT PERMIT GENERAL PROVISIONS

13-1.

1. This permit is issued under and subject to all laws and ordinances of agencies governing the encroachment herein permitted. See the following references:

STREETS AND HIGHWAYS CODE

1. Division 1, Chapter 3
2. Division 2, Chapter 2, Section 942
3. Division 2, Chapter 4, Section 1126
4. Division 2, Chapter 5.5 and Chapter 6

SAN JOAQUIN COUNTY ORDINANCES NUMBERED: 324, 441, 648, 662, 672, 695, 700, 860, 892, 3359, and 3675.

2. It is understood and agreed by the Permittee that the performance of any work under this permit shall constitute an acceptance of all the provisions contained herein and failure on the Permittee's part to comply with any provision will be cause for revocation of this permit. Except as otherwise provided for public agencies and franchise holders, this permit is revocable on five days notice.
3. All work shall be done subject to the supervision of and the satisfaction of the grantor. The Permittee shall at all times during the progress of the work keep the County Highway in as neat and clean condition as is possible and upon completion of the work authorized herein, shall leave the County Highway in a thoroughly neat, clean and usable condition.
4. The Permittee also agrees by the acceptance of this permit to properly maintain any encroachment structure placed by the Permittee on any part of the County Highway and to immediately repair any damage to any portion of the highway, which occurs as a result of the maintenance of the said encroachment structure, until such time as the Permittee may be relieved of the responsibility for such maintenance by the County of San Joaquin.
5. The Permittee also agrees by the acceptance of this permit to make, at its own expense, such repairs as may be deemed necessary by the County Department of Public Works.
6. It is further agreed by the Permittee that whenever construction, reconstruction or maintenance work upon the highway is necessary, the installation provided for herein shall, upon request of the County Department of Public Works, be immediately moved or removed by and at the sole expense of the Permittee.
7. No material used for fill or backfill in the construction of the encroachment shall be borrowed or taken from within the County right of way.
8. All work shall be planned and carried out with as little inconvenience as possible to the traveling public. No material shall be stacked within eight feet (8') of the edge of the pavement or traveled way unless otherwise provided herein. Adequate provision shall be made for the protection of the traveling public. Traffic control standards shall be utilized including barricades; approved signs and lights; and flagmen, as required by the particular work in progress.
9. The Permittee, by the acceptance of this permit, shall assume full responsibility for all liability for personal injury or damage to property which may arise out of the work herein permitted or which may arise out of the failure of the part of the Permittee to properly perform the work provided under this permit. In the event any claim of such liability is made against the County of San Joaquin or any department, official or employee thereof, the Permittee shall defend, indemnify, and hold each of them harmless for such claim.
10. All backfill material is to be moistened as necessary and thoroughly compacted with mechanical means. If required by the County Director of Public Works, such backfill shall consist of gravel or crushed rock. The Permittee shall maintain the surface over structures placed hereunder as may be necessary to insure the return of the roadway to a completely stable condition and until relieved of such responsibility by the County Department of Public Works. Wherever a gravel, crushed rock or asphalt surface is removed or damaged in the course of work related to the permitted encroachment, such material shall either be separately stored and replaced in the roadway as nearly as possible in its original state or shall be replaced in kind, and the roadway shall be left in at least as good a condition as it was before the commencement of operations of placing the encroachment structure.
11. Whenever it becomes necessary to secure permission from abutting property owners for the proposed work, such authority must be secured by the Permittee prior to starting work.
12. The current and future safety and convenience of the traveling public shall be given every consideration in the location and methods of construction utilized.
13. The Permittee is responsible for the preservation of survey monuments located within the area of work herein permitted. Prior to the start of construction, survey monuments that potentially may be disturbed shall be located and referenced by a Licensed Land Surveyor, and a Corner Record filed with the County Surveyor. Any Survey Monuments disturbed during the course of construction shall be reestablished by a Licensed Land Surveyor and another Corner Record filed with the County Surveyor. (Land Surveyors' Act Section 8771)
14. Prior to any excavation, the Permittee shall notify USA North (Underground Service Alert of Northern California and Nevada) at 811 or 800-227-2600 forty-eight (48) hours in advance.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS FOR
SOARING OVER RIPON (formerly known as Color The Skies)
ENCROACHMENT PERMIT

1. Traffic control shall be in accordance with the attached traffic control plan.
2. The traffic handling at designated intersections shall be provided by either California Highway Patrol or the San Joaquin County Sheriff Department. Applicant shall provide the County written verification from either entity prior to the event, by letter or email, confirming their involvement.
3. Provide advanced warning signs regarding the road closure and detour in accordance with the Caltrans MUTCD Standards.
4. Delays to the travelling public and local residents shall be kept to a minimum.
5. Residents shall be notified in writing, as approved by the County two weeks prior to the event. Provide a copy of the outreach documents to the County prior to the event.
6. Applicant shall notify and coordinate with all emergency services (fire, police, etc.) and the local postmaster a minimum of seven days prior to the event. Provide written verification to the County, prior to the event, from each entity by letter or email. Applicant shall fax Lifecom (209-236-8701) a description letter of the event with the date and time and a list of affected roads and provide the "sent" fax verification.
7. Event signage shall include directions to designated parking locations.
8. Emergency vehicle and local resident access shall be provided at all times.
9. A certificate of insurance, naming San Joaquin County as additional insured and certificate holder, must be submitted to the County prior to the event.
10. Marking of pavement (e.g. paint) is not allowed.
11. Roadway shall be completely cleared and open to the travelling public by 9:30 am. All related signage shall be removed by 9:30 am.

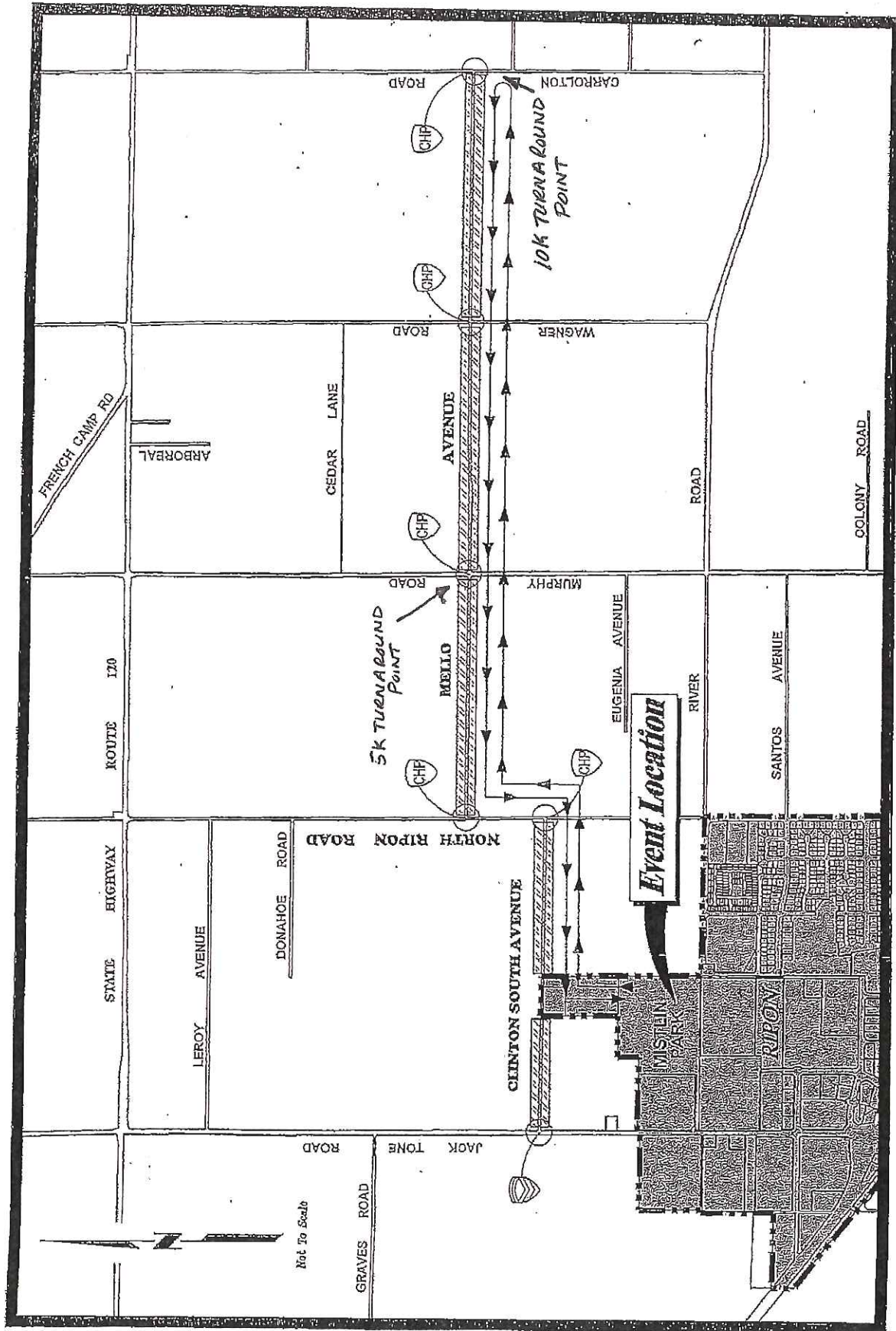

RESOLUTION APPROVING TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF CLINTON SOUTH AVENUE AND
MELLO AVENUE FOR THE SECOND ANNUAL COLOR THE SKIES HOT AIR BALLOON
FESTIVAL/RISE.SHINE.GIVE.RUN. EVENT

WHEREAS, Color The Skies, Inc., hereinafter referred to as APPLICANT, has applied for permission to temporarily close County portions of Clinton South Avenue, between Jack Tone Road and North Ripon Road, and Mello Avenue, between North Ripon Road and Murphy Road, for the Second Annual Color The Skies Hot Air Balloon Festival/Rise.Shine.Give.Run. event on Saturday, September 5, 2009 from 7:30 a.m. to 9:30 a.m.

WHEREAS, this is an annual event, it is anticipated that the APPLICANT will be requesting permission to temporarily close to traffic County portions of Clinton South Avenue, between Jack Tone Road and North Ripon Road, and Mello Avenue, between North Ripon Road and Murphy Road, for the Annual Color The Skies Hot Air Balloon Festival/Rise.Shine.Give.Run. on the Saturday during Labor Day Weekend in future years.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that it is the finding of this Board of Supervisors that, as authorized by Section 10-2700 of the Ordinance Code of San Joaquin County, it is necessary for the protection of the public to grant permission to temporarily close portions of Clinton South Avenue, between Jack Tone Road and North Ripon Road, and Mello Avenue, between North Ripon Road and Murphy Road, for the Second Annual Color The Skies Hot Air Balloon Festival/Rise.Shine.Give.Run. event on Saturday, September 5, 2009 from 7:30 a.m. to 9:30 a.m., and on the Saturday during Labor Day Weekend in future years.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this action shall be subject to the following conditions:

1. That an Encroachment Permit shall be obtained from the Department of Public Works for the temporary road closure.
2. That the performance of any procedures related to this Permit shall constitute an acceptance of all the provisions contained herein, and failure on APPLICANT'S part to comply with any provision will be cause for revocation of this Permit.
3. The APPLICANT shall provide a general advisory of the road closures for central distribution to local residents and emergency agencies two weeks prior to the event.

4. Provisions shall be made for the passage of local traffic. Advisory and detour signage will be placed in advance, and also on event day, along the route pursuant to the California Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices. California Highway Patrol will control major intersections and the Sheriff's Team of Active Retired Seniors will control minor intersections.
6. That should emergency conditions arise during the road closure period, temporary opening of the road shall be implemented immediately by APPLICANT.
7. That APPLICANT shall furnish and maintain any and all traffic control devices necessary to ensure the protection of the traveling public in accordance with all Federal, State, and County regulations, including terms, conditions, and/or restrictions stated herein or attached hereto, and that the advance warning, road closed, and detour signs may be made available by the County, and that the APPLICANT may contact the County Department of Public Works Traffic Division for the procedures on obtaining and installing said signs at least three days in advance of the signs being needed.
8. That APPLICANT will immediately make such repairs or perform any necessary work as required to leave the specified portion of County Highway in as neat, clean, and usable condition as existed prior to encroachment.
9. That APPLICANT will assume full responsibility for all liability for personal injury or damage to property, which may arise out of special road use described above, or which may arise out of failure to provide necessary safety described above, or which may arise out of failure to provide necessary safety devices and personnel.
10. That in the event any claim of such liability is made against the County of San Joaquin or any Department, official, or employee thereof, APPLICANT shall defend, indemnify, and hold them and each of them harmless of such claim.
11. That APPLICANT agrees to furnish a certificate to County indicating that APPLICANT has, and is maintaining, liability insurance insuring against legal liability for bodily injuries and death, and for damages to property in the amount of \$1,000,000. The above insurance shall be of the broad form coverage type. An additional insured endorsement to APPLICANT'S liability insurance policy naming County, its officers, and employees as additional insureds shall be furnished to County. Notwithstanding the above, APPLICANT'S liability insurance policy shall be endorsed as primary insurance. The certificate or policy of insurance shall state that COUNTY will be notified at least thirty (30) days before cancellation of the policy or any material change thereof. Adequate proof of insurance, in compliance with the above requirements, has been furnished to the Department of Public Works.
