05/18/2021	Complaint investigation about propate or weed killer smell in the Recreational Vehicle on site that is affecting the occupant's breathing and has caused skin irritation. As soon as I arrived to the RV park, I called she opened the gate for me. We used the second entrance to the left and her RV was parked at the far end to the left across from the Golf cart parking/storage area and the pump station for the RV's sewage. Behind the Golf cart storage area which is north, there is a field which seems to be getting ready to plant something, and to the west there is the river which we have had complaints about a sewage/swampy smell earlier this year. THEY LET ME IN THEIR RECREATIONAL VEHICLE AND WE TALKED ABOUT THE CHEMICAL SMELL THAT LASTED FOR THREE CONSECUTIVE DAYS AND HAS BEEN SLIGHTLY PRESENT. I COULD NOT SMELL ANYTHING INSIDE OR OUTSIDE THE RECREATIONAL VEHICLE. ADDITIONALLY, I WALKED AROUND THE EDGE OF THE PROPERTY LINE AND TOOK PICTURES OF THE FIELD BEING READY TO PLANT AND TOOK A PICTURE OF THE RIVER MOVING NORTH. I EXPLAINED BILLIE AT THE END THAT THERE MIGHT BE AT LEAST TWO FACTORS TO THE SMELL, INCLUDING THE CHEMICALS USED TO PLANT ON THE NEIGHBORING FIELD AND BEING CLOSE TO THE RIVER. I WAS UNABLE TO VERIFY HAZARDOUS WASTE NEAR THE RECREATIONAL VEHICLE PARK AT THE TIME OF MY INVESTIGATION. I took a picture of both the field and the river which did not look like had a serious algae issue. I told and her husband that I could not verify the smell or any hazardous waste near them to be able to post anything. I stated that I will talk to my supervisor and email the reports per their request at	SALINAS
